Over the years, our footprint has been steadily expanding, and today our interventions are reaching communities across 18 States and 2 Union Territories, with a cumulative outreach of over 4.15 lakh lives. Through every initiative, we are focusing on creating long-term impact rather than short-term solutions, ensuring that development reaches those who need it the most.

This year, our education initiatives are strengthening government schools through infrastructure development, digital and AI-enabled learning, scholarships, school transformation programmes, mobility support through bicycles and buses, sports development initiatives, and academic assistance. The inspiring journey of the girls' cricket team from Badnu, Rajasthan, is reminding us of what becomes possible when talent is supported with the right resources and encouragement. Across our programmes, we are helping transform learning experiences for thousands of students while creating pathways for academic and sporting excellence.

Across our empowerment initiatives, Community Development Centres are serving as hubs of opportunity, having impacted over 9,200 beneficiaries through digital literacy, vocational training, livelihood enhancement, entrepreneurship, and community participation. Simultaneously, we are supporting women, youth, farmers, and vulnerable groups through targeted interventions designed to strengthen self-reliance and economic resilience. Our commitment to environmental stewardship is being strengthened through plantation drives, cleanliness campaigns, river conservation awareness, waste management initiatives, and community-led environmental action. During the year, we have supported the plantation of over 9950 saplings and engaged hundreds of

community members in environmental initiatives. In health, we are expanding access through medical camps, nutrition support, ambulance services, blood donation drives, eye-care interventions, and public health programmes, collectively reaching over 24,000 individuals. Through rural electrification efforts, we are bringing clean energy solutions closer to underserved communities and have facilitated access to clean energy for over 1.6 lakh beneficiaries, reinforcing our belief that energy access can be a catalyst for development. We are actively collaborating with government institutions, civil society organisations, community leaders, and development partners to deepen our impact and reach. 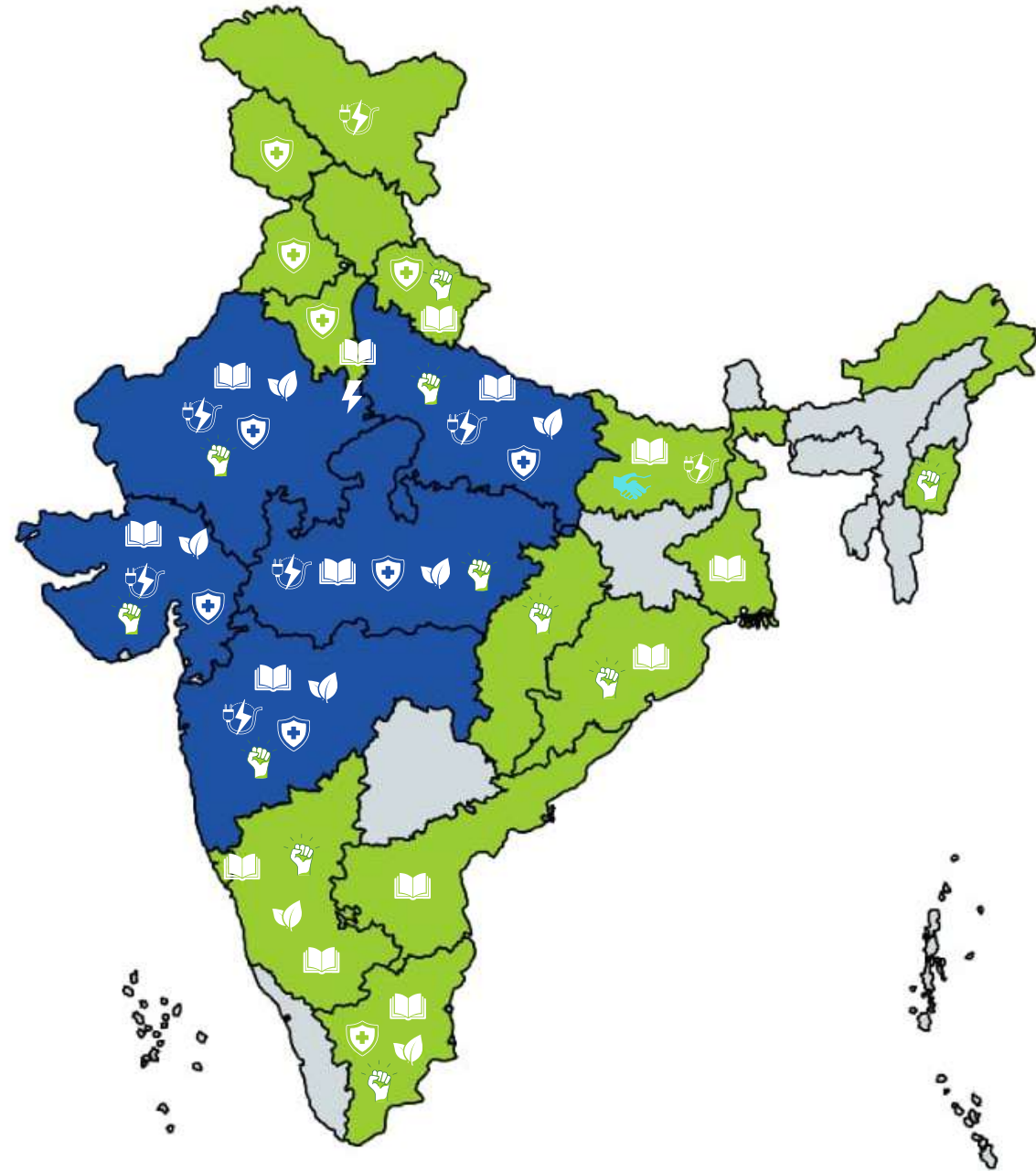

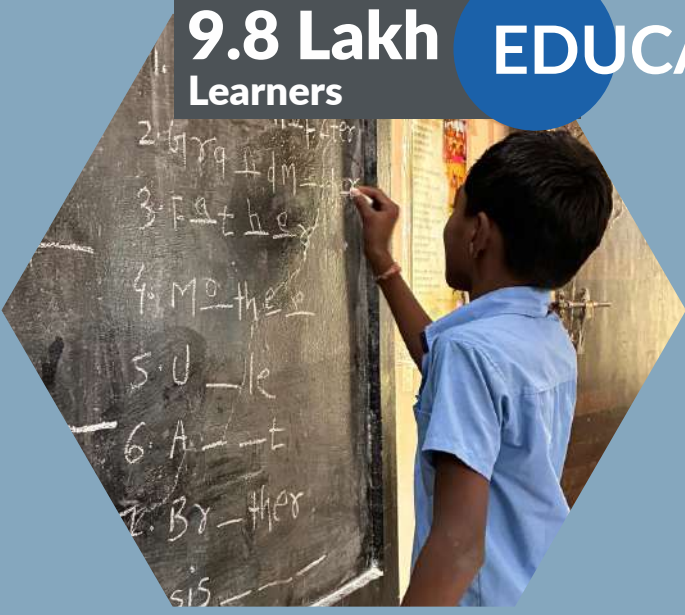

AVAADA UTKRISHT SHIKSHA ABHIYAN

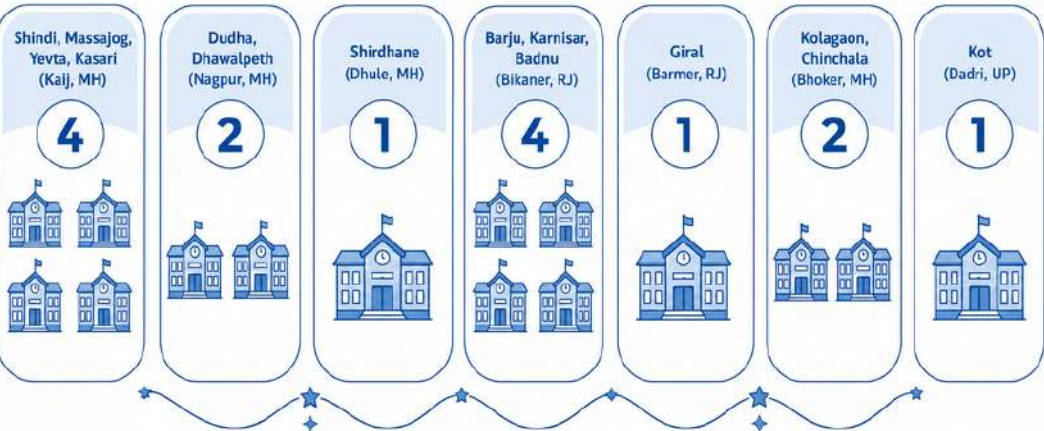
Education lies at the heart of Avaada Foundation's commitment to building resilient and self-reliant communities. Across tribal and underserved regions of Uttar Pradesh, particularly in the Prime Minister's adopted villages of Varanasi and Sonbhadra in Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, and urban communities, we are strengthening educational ecosystems by improving access, enhancing learning environments, and creating opportunities for holistic development.

Our interventions span school infrastructure development, digital and experiential learning, teacher capacity building, scholarships, academic support, and technology-enabled education. Through virtual classrooms, coaching centres, digital literacy initiatives, educational excursions, and innovative learning methodologies, we are helping bridge learning gaps and make quality education more accessible. Beyond academics, we are nurturing confidence, creativity, leadership, and life skills through sports, co-curricular activities, summer camps, and experiential learning programmes. By creating enabling environments where children and youth can learn, grow, and aspire, Avaada Foundation is empowering the next generation to realise their full potential and shape a brighter future for themselves and their communities.



GOVERNMENT SCHOOL RENOVATION AND UPGRADATION

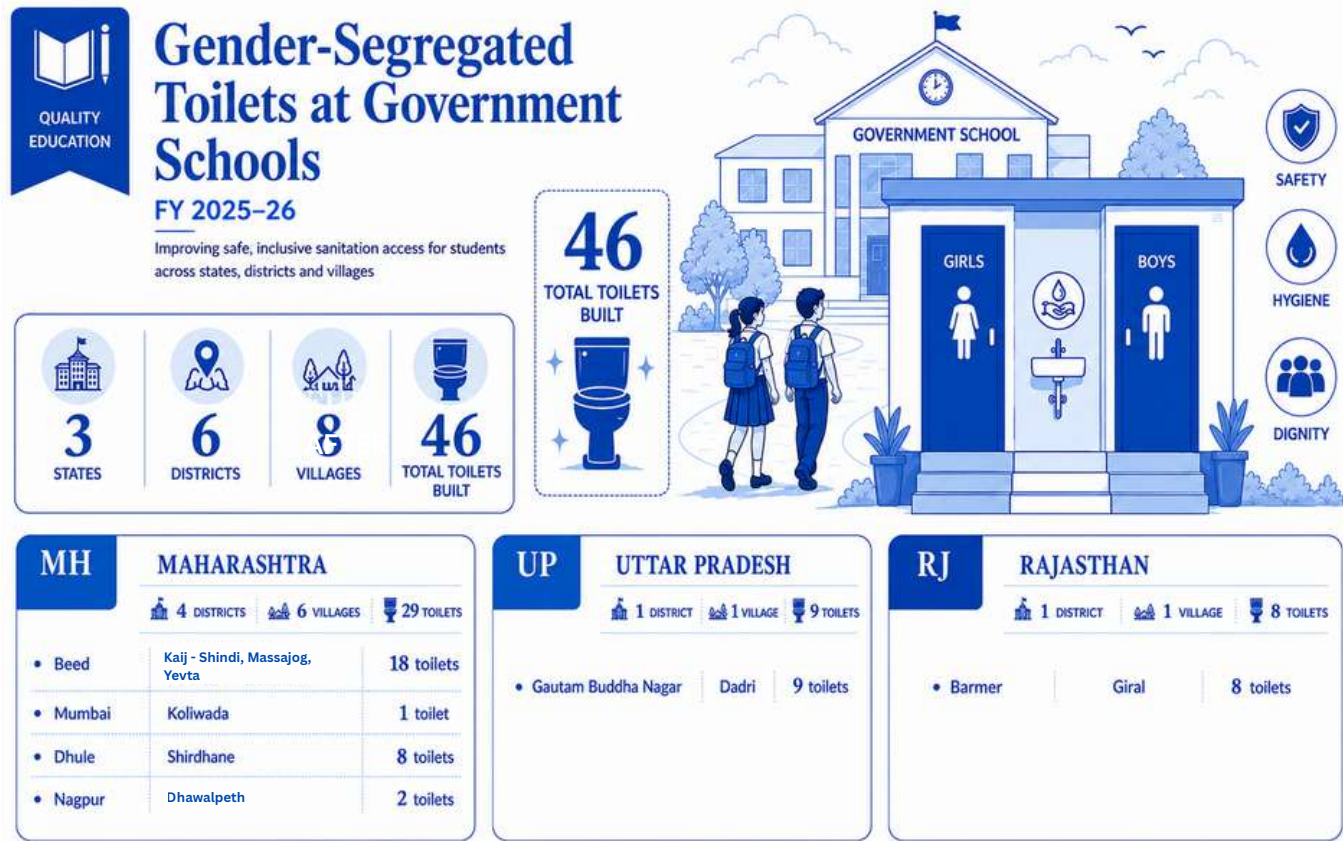
At Avaada Foundation, we are strengthening government school infrastructure to create safer, more inclusive, and conducive learning environments for children. Through the renovation and upgradation of schools, construction of sanitation facilities, provision of safe drinking water, interactive boards, plantation, rainwater harvesting systems, and dedicated transport support such as school buses and bicycles, we are improving access to quality education, particularly in rural and remote regions of Beed, Nagpur, Buldhana, Gautam Buddha Nagar, Dhule, Barmer, Bikaner and Nanded.



Beyond infrastructure, we are enriching learning ecosystems through virtual classrooms, coaching and tuition centres, and our 'Avaada Community Development Centers', where IIT graduates and trained educators provide subject-specific academic support to students. We are further promoting holistic development through educational trips, summer camps, spoken English classes, the 'Panini Mind Opening Technique,' teacher support initiatives, and a wide range of sports, creative, and skill-based activities.

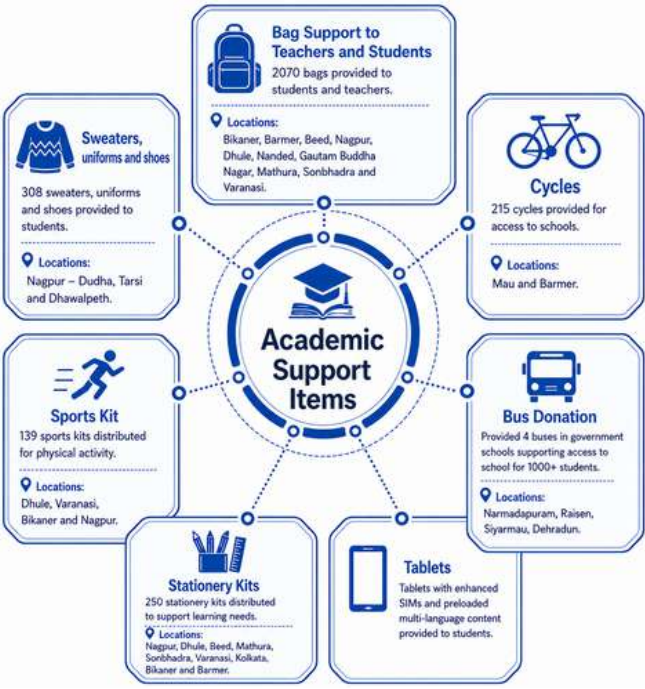

EMPOWERING EVERY CHILD TO LEARN

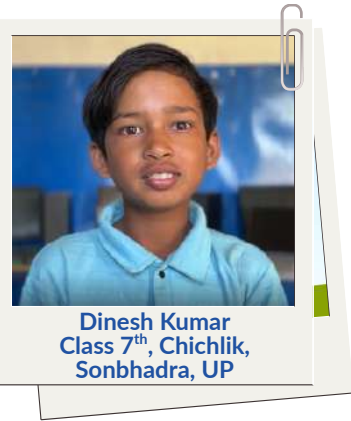
At Avaada Foundation, we are helping children step into classrooms with dignity, confidence, and hope. For many children in the communities we work with, even basic school essentials like uniforms, shoes, bags, and study materials were once out of reach, becoming barriers to regular attendance and learning.

Through the distribution of school bags, uniforms, sweaters, stationery kits, bicycles, and transport support, we are ensuring that no child is left behind due to lack of resources. By meeting these everyday needs, we are not only supporting education, but also inspiring children to stay in school, participate actively, and dream of a brighter future.



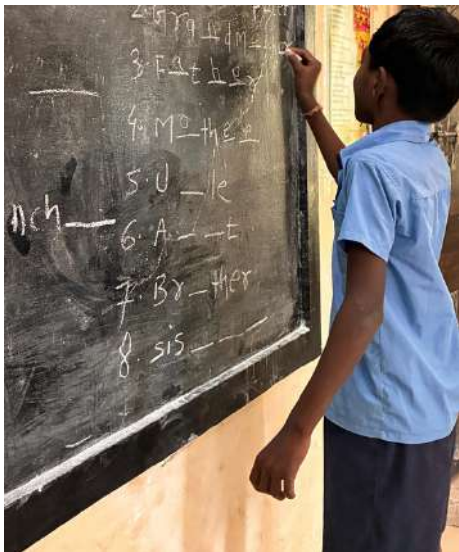
NURTURING DREAMS THROUGH QUALITY EDUCATION

Avaada Foundation adopted a comprehensive approach to strengthen educational outcomes by creating a supportive learning ecosystem for students with limited resources and exposure. To address the low student-teacher ratio, qualified teachers were deployed in government schools, providing 3–4 hours of focused academic support daily. The initiative also bridged the digital divide through virtual classes and the distribution of tablets with recharged SIM cards and preloaded, grade-appropriate content, enabling continued learning beyond classrooms. To inspire aspirations, laptops, desktop computers, and competitive exam preparation books were provided, alongside book fairs to encourage reading. 260+ students, from 4 villages; Karnisar Bhatiyani (Biknaer, RJ), Bhachau (Kachchh, GJ), Dudha (Nagpur, MH), Dhule (Shirdhane, MH) took their first trip and travelled outside their villages for educational trip to the Avaada-constructed planetarium in Dongla, Madhya Pradesh, and spiritual trip to Ujjain. Furthermore, 28 students boosted their STEM knowledge by visiting Avaada Solar Plant in Kaij, Beed, Maharashtra. Beyond academics, every week with the students, we have also been conducting various workshops and interactive activities focusing on real-life problem-solving skills. This helped broaden perspectives and build confidence. Motivational sessions, career counselling, public speaking and cyber security workshops further empowered students, nurturing not only academic growth but also hope and ambition for the future.

PANINI MIND OPENING TECHNIQUE

Avaada Foundation introduced new pedagogy, 'Panini Mind Opening Technique', an innovative, play-based pedagogy, to address the need for experiential learning in early grades where rote-based methods often limit conceptual understanding. The approach aligns with national priorities such as the NIPUN Bharat Mission and Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) by promoting sensory-based, child-centric learning. By creatively painting academic concepts and syllabus content on school walls, Avaada Foundation is transforming classrooms into interactive learning spaces where children learn through play and participation. Under this pedagogy activity-based learning takes shape using simple tools such as cards, blocks, and chalk are further making education engaging and enjoyable—encouraging even irregular students to attend school with greater enthusiasm and interest.

During the year, government school teachers from across project locations were trained in Sonbhadra through hands-on sessions using interactive tools, enabling them to simplify concepts in language, science, and mathematics.

Following the training, teachers returned to their respective schools and implemented the technique in their classrooms, resulting in more engaging and stress-free learning environments, improved student participation, and stronger foundational understanding. The initiative has begun to demonstrate positive changes in classroom practices, contributing to enhanced foundational learning outcomes and supporting holistic development among children.



SCHOLARSHIPS



Avaada Foundation's scholarship program supports 108 students from economically challenged backgrounds across states, enabling access to education otherwise hindered by financial barriers. We are supporting school education of students in Prime Minister Adopted villages Jayapur & Nagepur (in Varanasi), in 3 villages of Sonbhadra and 3 villages of Nagpur. Overall, 59 students are enrolled in our 2-year ITI Scholarship program from Sonbhadra, Nagpur and Bikaner and 56 are school-going students. At IIT Roorkee, we supported a research student for a health & technology project. The scholarship program covers admission, tuition, and living costs; empowering students to pursue skill-based, technical, and higher education.



In 2025, Avaada Foundation organised a Kabaddi tournament in our village. During the tournament, they announced scholarships for students aspiring to pursue ITI education, offering to cover the cost of our studies. For many of us, it felt almost unreal—we had never imagined that such an opportunity could be within our reach. But Avaada Foundation turned that promise into reality. With their continued support, not just I, but several of my peers from nearby villages were able to enrol in ITI and pursue our education without the burden of financial constraints.

For me, this support is more than a scholarship—it is the confidence to stand on my own feet and shape my future. Today, as I complete my first year of ITI, I move forward with renewed determination and bigger aspirations. I remain deeply grateful to Avaada Foundation for believing in us and enabling this journey of transformation.

AVAADA SPORTS AND RECREATIONAL CENTER, KOLIWADA, MUMBAI (MH)

Avaada Sports and Recreational Center being run by the Avaada Foundation in Koliwada is transforming young lives by offering purposeful alternatives to screen addiction and substance abuse. From 6 a.m. to 11 p.m., the center remains packed with students engaged in table tennis, archery, carrom, chess, yoga, spoken English, summer camp, and other co-curricular & recreational activities. It fosters discipline, breaks gender stereotypes, and builds confidence. With reduced mobile usage and focused engagement in constructive activities, the center has emerged as a vibrant and secure space—demonstrating that meaningful change is achievable when opportunities are made accessible.



SUMMER CAMPS

The Avaada Foundation organized one-month long summer camps across 4 states- Gujarat (Bhachau - Adohi, Halra), Uttar Pradesh (Sonbhadra and Varanasi), Maharashtra (Koliwada in Mumbai, Kaij, Nagpur), and Madhya Pradesh (Kumhar Pipaliya), reaching over 4,000 students. A wide range of activities, including art and craft competitions, Olympiads, dance contests, Shloka learning & recitations, storytelling & public speaking, and sports events, were conducted along with providing the kids with nutritional refreshments. These camps aim to promote critical thinking, team spirit, creativity, and a sense of community among children while ensuring that students made constructive use of their vacation time in a fun and structured manner.



SWAMI VIVEKANANDA STUDY CENTER, SHIRDHANE, DHULE

At Shirdhane, Dhule, Maharashtra, Avaada Foundation supports youth preparing for competitive examinations such as SSC, Police Recruitment exams, NEET, nursing, pharmacy, and engineering entrance tests. The Foundation has provided competitive exam books, laptops, a computer set, and an inverter to create a better learning environment. It also repaired the road leading to the study centre and developed a playground for physical practice related to police recruitment training. These initiatives have inspired the students to pursue their goals with renewed zeal and enthusiasm. Their dedication and hard work reflect the positive impact of the support, and we are confident they will achieve great success in the future.



EMPOWERMENT

AVAADA NAV KIRAN

Avaada Foundation is strengthening community empowerment by creating integrated platforms that enable skills, livelihoods, and opportunities to grow together. At the core of this approach is the flagship programme, the 'Avaada Community Development Centers', where we are training women in advanced-level stitching, crochet, and beautician skills, helping them take active steps towards income generation and financial independence. At the same time, we are building digital literacy among women and youth, while supporting students through coaching centers to strengthen their academic foundations. This year we set up 6 'Avaada Community Development Centers', while continuing with 3 previously set-up centers.

Beyond skilling, we are fostering confidence and aspiration through sports; developing playgrounds, training players, organizing tournaments, and providing essential equipment. We are also building strong community connect through cultural engagements, festival celebrations, and support to vulnerable families with livelihood resources. Through social security camps, we are further linking communities to government schemes, ensuring access to entitlements and strengthening overall well-being.

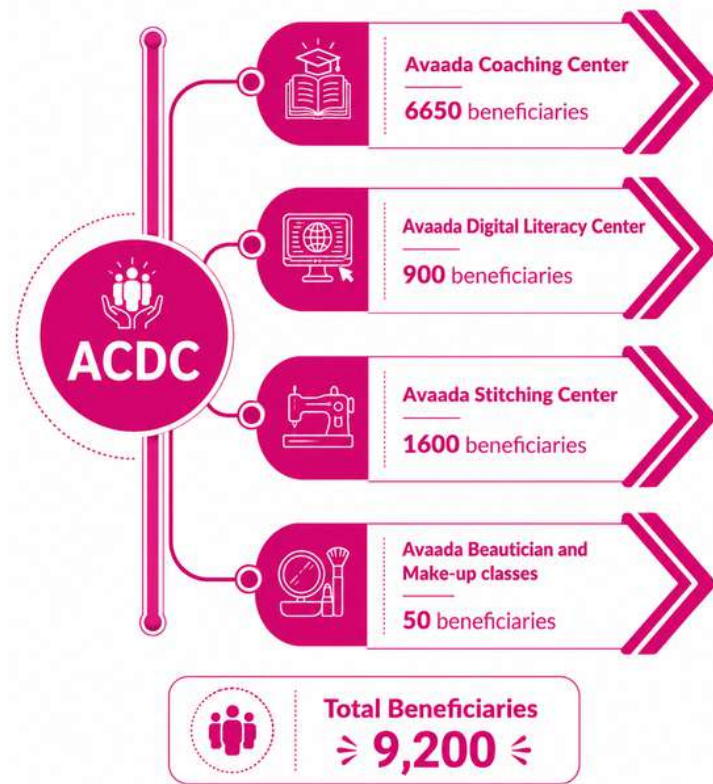
Integrated space for learning and skill development



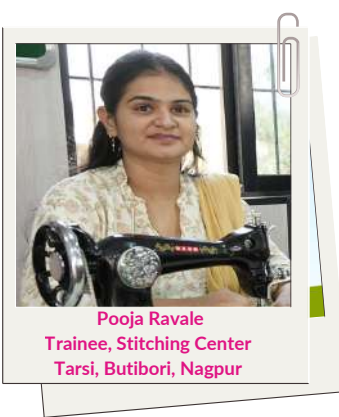
'Avaada Community Development Centers' serve as inclusive integrated space wherein in four rented rooms, each for free coaching centers, free digital centers, free stitching & crochet and skilling trainings support in holistic community development. At places like Bhachau and May Gaon (Kachchh, Gujarat) and Lahuri (Kaij), we renovated the community building for community development center.

These centers provide structured academic coaching for students from Grades 1 to 12, strengthening foundational learning and improving academic outcomes. Alongside, digital literacy programs range from basic computer skills to introductory coding, equipping participants with essential competencies for today's digital world. To boost the digital learning and career advancement, we have donated 18 computers in Sangli (Pune) and Shirdhane (Dhule). These digital learning centers has supported many youth to secure and employment and still continues to do so. Furthermore, through our empowerment initiatives, we have also supported 50 local youth in securing employment.

These centers also deliver livelihood-focused training, 'Avaada Navkiran Stitching Center' (includes stitching & crochet training), diya & bag making workshops, 'Avaada Beauty and Make-up Class' etc. for women, enabling them to build market-relevant skills and transition towards income generation in the regions of Sonbhadra, Kaij, Dhule, Tarsi, Bhoker, Bikaner, Ladvan, Bhachau. For continued support, we donated 50 industrial and tailor-model machines to women. By combining education, digital access, and skilling within the community, these centers are creating pathways for confidence, self-reliance, and long-term socio-economic empowerment.



Every woman and youth from our 'Avaada Community Development Center' receives advanced level training in diverse skill, get certification and with our support pursues entrepreneurship. Many of our skilled women today have regular income generation with the help of our industry linkages.

CULTIVATING NUTRITION & LIVELIHOOD THROUGH KITCHEN GARDENS IN SONBHADRA AND KAIJ

Avaada Foundation is strengthening household-level food security through the promotion of kitchen gardens in Sonbhadra and Kaij. By enabling 300+ beneficiaries to utilise available spaces for cultivation, the initiative is improving access to fresh, nutritious, and chemical-free produce.

Through the distribution of quality seeds and saplings, along with guidance on sustainable farming practices, households are being supported to grow vegetables throughout the year. This approach is not only enhancing nutritional intake but also reducing dependence on market purchases, particularly for vulnerable families.

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

In many of these villages, sports infrastructure and awareness were previously absent, and youth, students, and the wider community had limited exposure to sports as a pathway for growth or aspiration. With Avaada Foundation's presence, we are now witnessing a visible and rapid rise in sports participation, interest, and ambition across these communities. Avaada Foundation is fostering a strong culture of fitness, discipline, and aspiration among rural youth by strengthening developing sports ground, uplifting grassroots sports infrastructure and promoting active participation. We are developing sports grounds across our locations, with communities actively benefiting from facilities at Tarsi (Nagpur, MH), Jayapur (Varanasi, UP), and Shirdhane (Dhule, MH), reaching 4,000+ youth. In Shirdhane, we are supporting 50–60 young aspirants through a dedicated 400-meter running track, enabling preparation for Police, Defence, and other competitive physical examinations.



SPORTS TRAINING & COACHING

Across project locations, structured sports training and exposure were previously limited, with minimal access to coaching or diverse sporting disciplines. Avaada Foundation is now actively building this ecosystem by delivering multi-sports training programs in villages such as Kumhar Pipaliya, Nagepur, Dudha, Tarsi, Shirdahne, Chichlik, Basuhari covering Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Cricket, Football, Lathi, and self-defence—collectively reaching 870 youth. These efforts are steadily strengthening grassroots capabilities, improving physical fitness, and nurturing early-stage sporting talent across communities.



EQUIPMENT SUPPORT

In many of our intervention villages, sports was never a part of everyday life. Young people had the interest, but not the access—no playgrounds, no equipment, and no guidance to pursue it seriously. As a result, sports remained limited to occasional play, with little awareness of the opportunities it could create. Recognising this gap, Avaada Foundation is building a strong foundation by bringing structured training, basic resources, providing sports equipments in schools, and regular platforms for youth to participate and grow. We have signed a long-term MOU with Women's Cricket Team, Badnu (Bikaner, Rajasthan) under which we are sponsoring and supporting the team with complete sports kits & gear, travel, training, food, stadium fee and ground development — ensuring the best resources reaches the team. We are further supporting youth players by distributing jerseys in Shirdhane, providing running shoes and sports kits to players in Nagepur.



CONDUCTING TOURNAMENTS

We are further scaling participation by organizing and enabling competitive platforms, with 3000+ participants engaged in 4-days and nights Mega Kabaddi tournaments across locations including Dudha and Tarsi (Nagpur, MH). Large-scale events such as Avaada Khel Utkarsh (462 participants) and Avaada Khel Mahotsav in Shirdhane (500+ participants) are creating structured avenues for inter-school and village-level competition. At the same time, we are organise annual summer camps across multiple locations, reaching 4,088 participants, where children actively engage in sports, fitness, and team activities. Along with community-led events like 'Run for Unity' in Barju, these efforts are building confidence, increasing participation, and helping young people see sports as a pathway to opportunity and growth. Additional engagement through cricket tournaments, sponsoring Sansand Khel Mahotsav in Gujarat, urban Sports & Recreation Centers in Mumbai, and international exposure by sponsoring the Indian Pickleball team is collectively expanding access, deepening aspiration, and building a vibrant, inclusive sports culture from grassroots to global platforms.



TALENT IDENTIFICATION

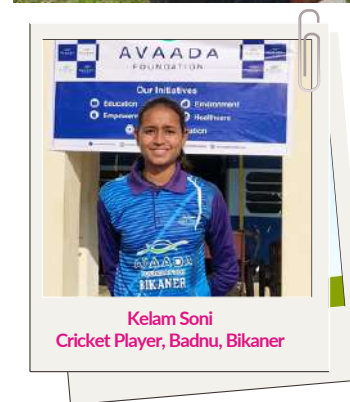
In many rural communities, talent often remains unseen due to lack of exposure, platforms, and guidance. Our continuous focused efforts are now identifying and nurturing this potential by creating structured opportunities for youth to showcase their abilities. Through regular sports activities, camps, and local competitions, we are recognizing emerging talent early and encourage to pursue sports with greater intent and confidence.

By providing access to training, mentorship, and essential resources, promising players are being supported to progress to higher levels of competition. Participation in inter-village and district-level tournaments is further enabling visibility and growth. These initiatives are not only identifying talent but also building a pathway for young athletes to develop their skills, compete, and aspire for opportunities beyond their communities.

ADVANCED NURTURING

We take advanced step towards advanced nurturing of young athletes and help them in realizing their full potential. Continuous training programs are being conducted to strengthen skills, improve performance, and build discipline, ensuring that promising players receive consistent guidance and support over time.

Players are being actively linked to district, state, and national-level tournaments, enabling exposure, competitive experience, and visibility. At the same time, required support such as shoes, jerseys, sports kits, and other essential resources is being provided to ensure that financial constraints do not hinder progress. We also extended financial and institutional support to Foundation for Promotion of Sports and Games, for training, and development of Olympic and Paralympic athletes to foster sporting excellence and inclusive participation in national and international events.



Avaada Foundation's support to Women's Cricket Team has been really helpful. Right from providing us with sports equipments, to travel expenses and practice & training, I and the team express our deepest gratitude. With their support, we are able to work towards achieving dreams that once we thought are figments of imagination. Before Avaada Foundation's came to our village, I never thought I will be able to pursue my career as a sportsperson due to limited resources, but with Avaada Foundation's support and their trust, I am getting closer towards achieving my aim of being a cricketer.

In 2023, Avaada Foundation organised a summer camp, and I participated in it. During the camp, I played a lot games, and it was then when Avaada Foundation team discovered me and my passion for sports, especially Kabaddi. Since then, I have been fortunate to receive training for Kabaddi and practice daily at the community sports ground developed by Avaada Foundation. Furthermore, installation of the CCTV camera at the sports ground keeps the environment safe and secure, especially for girls who come to practice from far off villages. I express my deepest gratitude to Avaada Foundation for providing us with all the resources and training, helping us achieve our dreams.

CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT THROUGH FESTIVALS

Across project locations, access to shared cultural platforms and community celebrations was previously limited, resulting in fewer opportunities for collective engagement and social cohesion. Avaada Foundation is now actively fostering community connect by enabling large-scale festivals and cultural celebrations, reaching over 27,240 individuals. Through structured observance of national and cultural events, including Diwali Melas, Children’s Day, Teachers’ Day, Independence Day, Republic Day, Gita Jayanti, Holi, Durga Puja, Kanya Puja, Community Feast, Shivaji Jayanti, Hindi Diwas, and Constitution Day; we are engaging a total of 39,000+ participants, strengthening cultural awareness, pride, and community participation.



SHARED EXPERIENCES....

We further reinforce dignity and inclusion by distributing sarees and suits to 1,860+ women across locations including Shirdhane (Dule, MH), Tarsi (Nagpur, MH), Sonbhadra (UP), Mundsar, and Karnisar Bhatiyar (Bikaner, RJ). These initiatives are creating shared experiences, strengthening social bonds, and belongingness within communities, while ensuring that cultural participation becomes inclusive and accessible.

SOCIAL SECURITY

At Avaada Foundation, we are working towards bridging the gap between communities and essential government welfare schemes by organising Social Security Camps at the village level. These camps are serving as important platforms to improve awareness, facilitate registrations, and strengthen last-mile access to entitlements related to health, livelihood, and social protection.

During the year, Social Security Camps conducted in Dudha and Tarsi (Nagpur, MH) facilitated the generation of 285 Ayushman cards and 24 e-Shram cards, enabling families to access healthcare benefits and social security provisions. Similar efforts are also being undertaken in Sonbhadra, (in UP) where communities are being supported in connecting with relevant government schemes and services.

In addition, Avaada Foundation is extending wedding support to 15 girls from economically vulnerable families across Jayapur & Nagepur (Varanasi, UP), Sonbhadra (UP), Bhachau (Kachchh, GJ), Mumbai (MH), Agar (MP), and Banda (UP), helping ease financial burdens and supporting families during important life events with dignity and care.

Through these interventions, Avaada Foundation continues to strengthen access, enhance awareness, and ensure that communities are meaningfully connected to opportunities and support systems designed for their well-being and security.



ENVIRONMENT

AVAADA TARU SRIJAN

Avaada Foundation is driving environmental sustainability by nurturing ecosystems, promoting responsible resource use, and building climate resilience within communities, especially in vulnerable and last-mile regions. Through a blend of green interventions and community engagement, we are addressing both immediate environmental challenges and long-term ecological balance. We are restoring green cover through plantation drives using the Miyawaki technique, enabling the rapid growth of dense, native forests that improve biodiversity, air quality, and carbon absorption. Alongside this, we are encouraging self-sustenance and nutrition through the development of kitchen gardens, empowering households to grow their own fresh produce while fostering a deeper connection with nature. Our efforts also focus on improving sanitation and waste management through cleanliness drives and the deployment of garbage collection vans, ensuring cleaner, healthier living environments. In parallel, we are strengthening community preparedness through disaster relief initiatives and resilience workshops, equipping individuals with the knowledge and resources to respond effectively to environmental and climate-related challenges.



TREE PLANTATION

By strengthening green belt initiative Avaada Foundation is implementing focused fruit bearing and green cover plantation initiatives across its project locations. These efforts are contributing to biodiversity restoration and creating sustainable green spaces within communities. Plantation drives are being undertaken across multiple geographies, Pangaon, Dhamangaon, Pune, Kaij (Beed) and Dhamangaon (MH); Kuchor and Badnu (Bikaner, RJ); Bhachau & Surendranagar (Gujarat); Agar (Madhya Pradesh) and Banda, Badaun & Banka (UP). Interventions are also extending to institutional spaces such as schools, where plantation activities are enhancing the learning environment and promoting environmental awareness among students. Under the Own a Tree initiative, 6,750 fruit-bearing saplings were planted across 18 acres with an impressive 92% survival rate. Furthermore, under green belt development, around 3200 saplings were planted across 8 acres. Through these efforts, Avaada Foundation is not only expanding green cover but also building long-term community engagement towards environmental conservation.



CLEANLINESS DRIVES

Avaada Foundation is strengthening environmental stewardship through structured cleanliness drives aimed at improving sanitation and promoting healthier living conditions across communities. These initiatives are designed to encourage collective responsibility while addressing gaps in waste management and public hygiene.

Implemented across Koliwada (Mumbai, MH), Jayapur & Nagepur (Varanasi, UP), Aiho (Bhachahu, Kachchh, GH) and Barju & Karnisar Bhatiyani (Bikaner, RJ), the drives focus on cleaning public spaces, supporting better waste disposal practices, and restoring commonly used areas to safe and hygienic conditions. By engaging local communities in these efforts, the Foundation is fostering ownership and sustained behavioural change.

Through these interventions, Avaada Foundation is contributing to cleaner surroundings, improved public health, and a stronger culture of environmental responsibility at the community level.



ECO-FRIENDLY GANPATI MAKING INITIATIVE

Avaada Foundation is fostering environmental stewardship among the younger generation through its inspiring Eco-Friendly Ganpati Making workshops in Kaij, Beed (MH). By transforming a traditional cultural celebration into a practical lesson in sustainability, the foundation encourages students to craft Ganesh idols using natural, biodegradable clay. This initiative beautifully demonstrates that spiritual devotion and ecological responsibility can go hand in hand, moving away from harmful materials in favor of earth-friendly practices.



DISASTER RELIEF AND RESILIENCE WORKSHOP

Avaada Foundation is strengthening community resilience through disaster preparedness and safety awareness initiatives. As part of this effort, workshops are being conducted in schools on Jayapur (Varanasi, UP), to build awareness and preparedness at an early age. Through practical demonstrations and interactive sessions, students are being equipped with essential knowledge on risk identification, emergency response, and basic life-saving techniques.

GARBAGE COLLECTION VAN

Avaada Foundation is strengthening local waste management systems through targeted infrastructure support, including the donation of a garbage collection vehicle in Adhoi, Bahchau, Gujarat. The van is equipped with a hydraulic tipper and dual-compartment waste body. The van comes with a bucket capacity of 2.0 m³, two-compartment system for separate collection of wet and dry waste and 4060 MS-sheet-covered body with four openable windows. This intervention is improving the efficiency of waste collection and transportation, reducing accumulation in public spaces and enabling safer disposal practices.



HEALTH
AVAADA SWASTHYA

Avaada Foundation is strengthening community health by improving access to essential healthcare services, preventive care, and basic well-being support, especially in last-mile regions. Through a combination of medical interventions, nutrition support, and health awareness, we are addressing both immediate needs and long-term health outcomes.

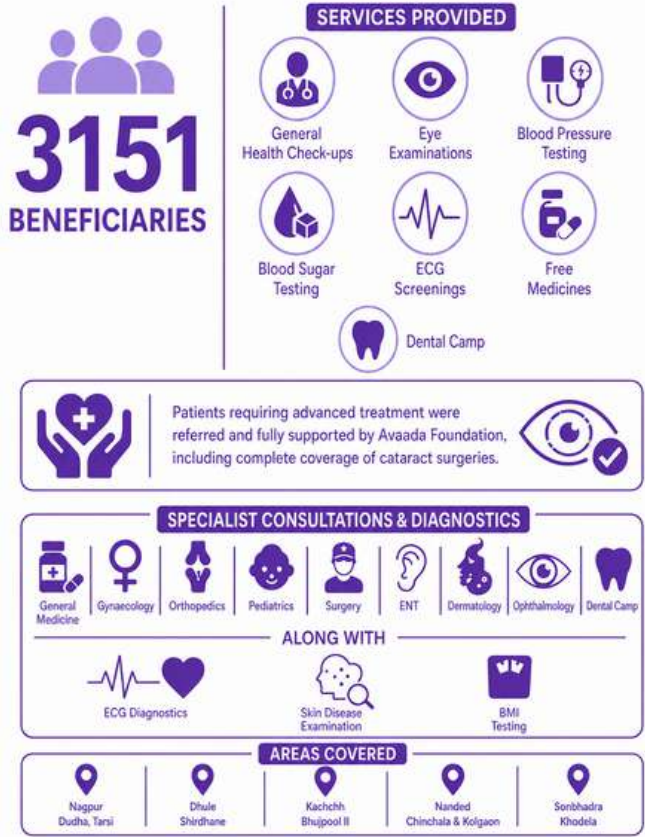
We are delivering healthcare access through medical camps and BMI testing drives, alongside targeted initiatives such as polio camps, menstrual health sessions, and oral health awareness programs. Emergency response is being strengthened through ambulance services handling critical cases across maternal care, accidents, and emergencies. At the same time, we are supporting vulnerable communities through ration kits distributed during festivals and on a regular basis, along with seasonal support through blankets, sweaters, and clothing for individuals.

To improve healthcare infrastructure and hygiene, we are installing water stations, filtration units, and storage tanks across locations, while also supporting facilities like PHCs with air-conditioning in maternity wards. These efforts are ensuring better patient care, access to clean water, and overall improvement in health and well-being at the community level.



MEDICAL CAMPS

We strengthen access to primary healthcare by conducting large-scale medical camps and preventive health initiatives across communities. Through our medical camps, we impact 3151 beneficiaries at various locations. These camps consist of BMI testing, providing a range of services including general health check-ups, basic diagnostics, maternal and child health support, and referrals for specialized care where required. These camps are bringing essential healthcare services closer to communities that often face barriers to access, enabling early detection of health issues and timely intervention. Alongside service delivery, we are also promoting awareness around preventive healthcare, encouraging communities to adopt healthier practices and seek regular medical support, thereby improving overall health outcomes. We provide compassionate care by supporting individuals in need, helping vulnerable families, and ensuring timely medical treatment.

Today, we can both see clearly again and live more independently. POLIO CAMP

A Polio Immunization Camp was conducted in Bikaner, reaching 66 beneficiaries. Beyond administering vaccines, the initiative represented a vital step toward safeguarding children's futures, protecting them from a preventable yet life-altering disease. Through awareness and care, the camp reinforced the importance of immunization, nurturing healthier, stronger, and more resilient communities.

BLOOD DONATION

Blood donation camps across Shirdhane, Nagpur, and Mumbai to promote voluntary blood donation and strengthen access to lifesaving healthcare support. Under this initiative we collected 108 units blood, encouraged community participation and created awareness around the importance of regular blood donation.



MENSTRUAL AWARENESS SESSION

A Menstrual Awareness Session was conducted in Dudha, Nagpur, benefiting 50 participants. The session focused on menstrual hygiene, safe practices, and breaking common myths and taboos. Through interactive discussions, participants gained better awareness and confidence to manage their menstrual health effectively and promote healthy practices within their communities.

NUTRITIONAL KIT

Avaada Foundation is addressing nutritional needs and food security among vulnerable communities through the distribution of ration and nutritional kits. Reaching 5,264 beneficiaries, these interventions include both one-time and periodic distributions aligned with community needs, including support during festivals such as Akshaya Tritiya. The initiative is strengthening household food security, supporting the nutritional needs of TB patients, and ensuring that vulnerable families are able to maintain health and well-being during periods of need.

DRINKING WATER

Access to safe drinking water remains a critical challenge across many rural and semi-urban regions, where communities often rely on limited or unsafe sources, impacting health, and overall quality of life. Recognizing water as a necessity and foundation for dignity and well-being, Avaada Foundation has been actively working to bridge this gap through targeted water infrastructure interventions. In 2025–26, Avaada Foundation strengthened its commitment by setting-up and water stations across Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh. This include 3 pre-casted drinking water stations of 5000-litre each and one 12,000-litre water station in Vida (Kaij, Beed, Maharashtra), installation of high-capacity 15,000-litre and 5000-litre water units in Poogal (Bikaner, Rajasthan). Additionally, we set-up water stations at Shri Jawahar High School in Kot (Dadri, Uttar Pradesh) and across schools in Giral (Barmer, Rajasthan), ensuring that both public institutions and educational spaces have access to clean water.



WINTER RELIEF SUPPORT

Avaada Foundation distributed 2,146 woolens, including sweaters, blankets, and clothes to vulnerable women, adolescent girls, and children across Barmer & Bikaner (Rajasthan), Bhachau (Gujarat), Mumbai, Nanded, Nagpur & Dhule (Maharashtra), and Sonbhadra & Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh). This seasonal initiative not only provided essential warmth but also brought comfort and dignity to those facing harsh winter conditions. By protecting communities from extreme cold, it helped reduce cold-related hospitalizations, especially among the elderly and most at-risk groups, fostering a sense of care, safety, and improved well-being during the winter months.



AMBULANCE - AVAADA JEEVAN RATH

One ambulance service and a mortuary van in Kathua, Jammu & Kashmir; and one ambulance in Bhairukheera, Rajasthan, has transformed emergency response in the remote regions, reducing critical response time. Over the past year, the service has supported 500+ residents during crucial and emergency situations, including maternal care & institutional delivery, accidents, and other life-threatening conditions. The ambulance service ensured emergency healthcare by transporting patients from remote villages to hospitals located up to 50 km away, including a significant number of cases requiring support during midnight. This initiative has not only improved access to healthcare but has also ensured timely medical assistance, saving many lives. The service is expected to continue addressing community needs and contributing positively to the healthcare sector in the future.



AC INSTALLATION IN GOVERNMENT HOSPITAL

Air-conditioning support was provided to the maternity ward at PHC Badnu to enhance comfort and ensure a safer environment for mothers and newborns. This intervention helps maintain appropriate temperatures, improves hygiene conditions, and supports better maternal and neonatal care, especially during extreme weather conditions.

RURAL ELECTRIFICATION

AVAADA URJA GRAM

Reliable electricity continues to remain a critical gap across many rural and remote regions, affecting daily life, safety, education, and access to essential services. In several communities, limited or inconsistent power supply restricts productivity, creates an unsafe environment, and impacts the functioning of schools and healthcare facilities. Addressing this need, we actively enable access to clean, dependable energy solutions that improve quality of life and support community development.

Through our solar power systems, solar and LED streetlights installation across diverse regions, we continue enhancing safety, mobility, and public infrastructure. In addition, critical institutions are being supported through inverters, batteries, and trolley systems in schools and healthcare facilities, including maternity wards, ensuring uninterrupted power supply. These interventions are collectively benefiting over 19,103 individuals, while promoting sustainable energy adoption and strengthening resilience at the grassroots level.



SOLAR LIGHTS

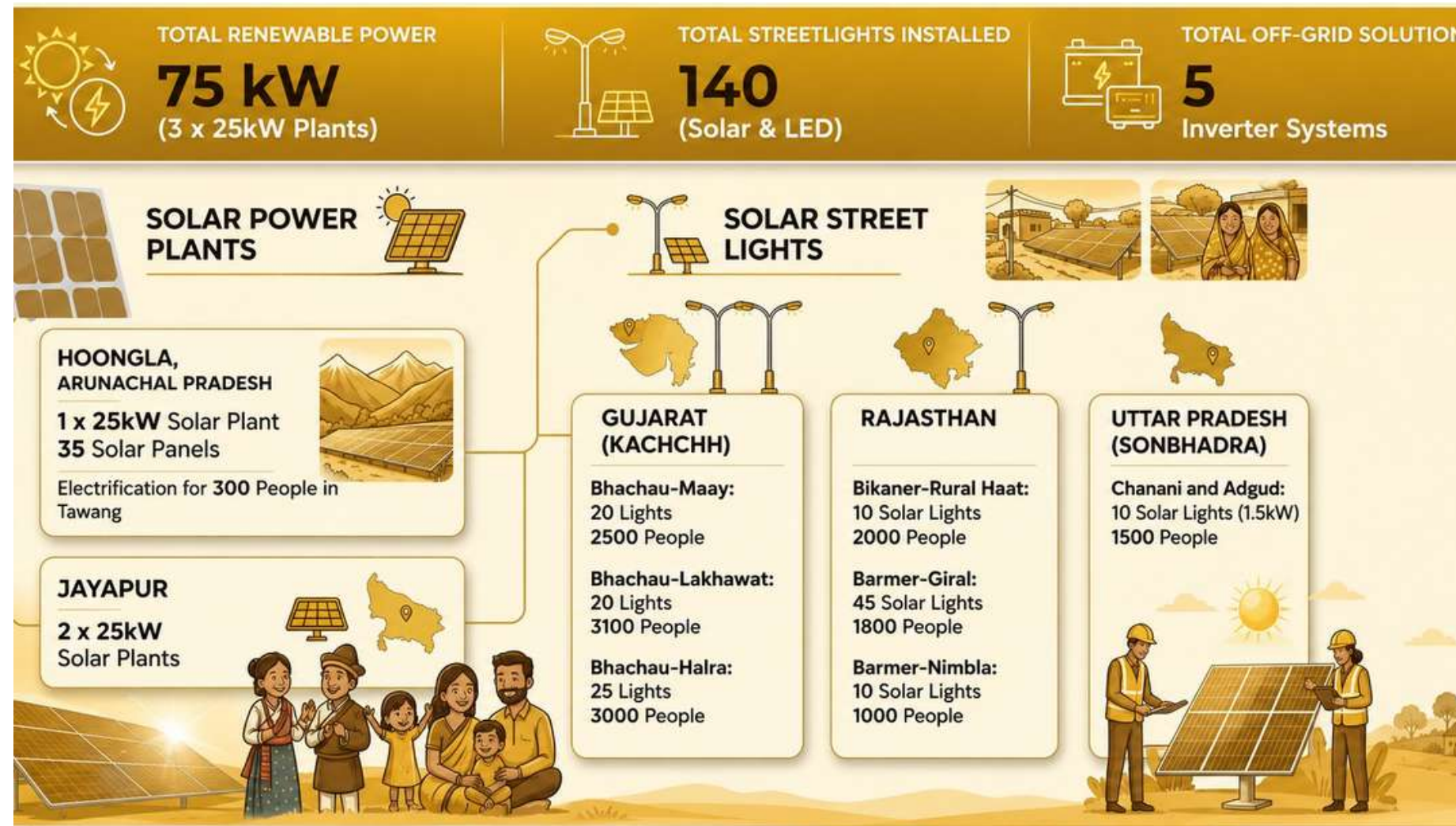
Avaada Foundation continues to make significant strides in rural empowerment through its extensive solar electrification initiatives, successfully deploying through 2 power plants of 25KW in PM Adopted Village, Jayapur (Varanasi, UP) for past 11 years. By establishing solar power plants in regions like Hoongla (Arunachal Pradesh), the Foundation has brought sustainable energy to hundreds of residents, fostering growth in previously underserved areas. Beyond large-scale plants, the initiative has illuminated communities by installing 140 solar and LED streetlights across Bhachahu (Kachchh, GJ), Bikaner (RJ), and Sonbhadra (UP) enhancing safety and extending economic hours for over 17,200 beneficiaries.

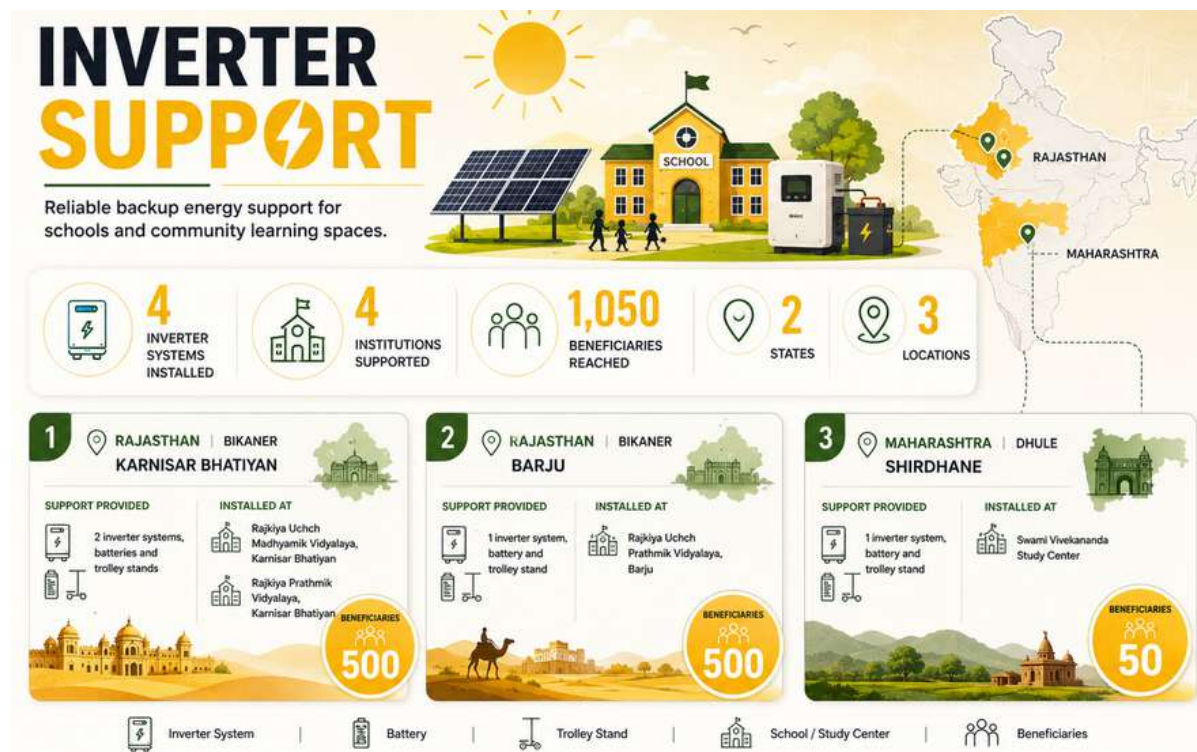

INVERTER

Avaada Foundation is strengthening access to reliable energy solutions by supporting educational institutions with inverter and battery systems across Rajasthan and Maharashtra. During the year, inverter systems were installed at Rajkiya Uchch Madhyamik Vidyalaya and Rajkiya Prathmik Vidyalaya in Karnisar Bhatiyani, Bikaner, Rajkiya Uchch Prathmik Vidyalaya in Barju, Bikaner, and Swami Vivekananda Study Center in Shirdhane, Dhule. A cornerstone of this mission is the support for critical healthcare infrastructure, exemplified by the electrification of maternity wards at PHC Badnu in Rajasthan. These interventions are ensuring uninterrupted access to electricity, creating better learning environments, and strengthening essential infrastructure for students and communities.



NEW BEGINNINGS

At Avaada Foundation, we believe that lasting change is never created in silos, it is built through collective ownership. Every new initiative is therefore designed and launched in close collaboration with the local administration, community leaders, grassroots institutions, and the people it is meant to serve.

For us, the start of a project is never just an operational milestone or a date on the calendar. Each beginning is celebrated as a community festival—an occasion filled with hope, pride, and shared progress. Launch events come alive through cultural performances, songs, and dances by local students and community members.

Residents are invited not merely to witness new opportunities, but to actively participate in shaping them. Community members are recognised, felicitated, and welcomed with warmth, with refreshments and meals served as a gesture of togetherness and hospitality.

Representatives from the local administration are also invited as chief guests, reinforcing partnership, accountability, and continuity.

At Avaada Foundation, every new beginning is not just the launch of a project—it is the celebration of a shared future.



SHRI JAWAHAR HIGH SCHOOL, DADRI COMPLETE SCHOOL RENOVATION & UPGRADATION

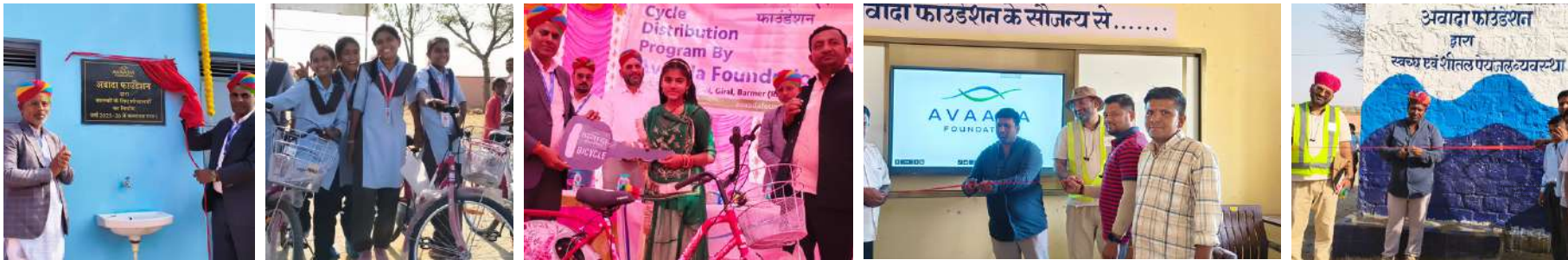
